Golf Challenge Cumulative Total Hits \$1.5 Million! And You Beat Last Year's Total!!!

We are over the moon that our total as of June 14 is an amazing \$126,758!! When added to all of the previous year's funds, the cumulative total is amazing!

This is also the 9th consecutive year that we have beat the previous year's total, and with the exception of 3 out of 19 years, every year there has been an increase in the final total over the previous year. This is the highest amount of sponsorship donations ever, and the second highest total raised by our fundraiser golfers. This is only possible because of the dedicated commitment of everyone involved to share the story of seniors in need, and how all of the donated dollars help to provide for those needs.
